



Red Pine is native to Michigan and provides winter food for birds and other wildlife. Fast growing (up to a foot plus per year once established) reaching heights of 50-80' when mature. Considered a long lived tree, it is shade intolerant and grows best on well-drained sandy loam soil. Excellent tree for reforestation on sandy sites. Important timber tree with distinctive reddish bark.
